

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the appropriate fee. Cheques should be made payable to "Armagh show".
2. Entry forms to be submitted in duplicate to the secretary. One form will be returned to exhibitors along with exhibit numbers which must be securely attached to exhibits.
3. The competition in these sections will be open unless otherwise stated.
4. Each entry must be the bona-fide work of the person in whose name it is to be exhibited.
5. Work entered into the wrong class will be transferred into the correct class. The numbers supplied by the secretary must be securely attached to the exhibits and every care will be taken, but the committee will not be responsible for mistakes.
6. Reasonable care will be taken of all exhibits, but the committee will not be accountable for any loss, damage, or injury that may occur to any exhibit before, during, or after the show.
7. All persons entering the exhibition marquees are subject to the direction of the stewards and the secretary.
8. **Entries in these sections close on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2011.**
9. Exhibitors sending exhibits by post and desiring their return are requested to note that remittance to cover return postage must accompany the entries. Exhibits in the baking, preserves and egg sections are not returnable by post.
10. Exhibitors are responsible for placing their exhibits in the appropriate section of the exhibition tent.
11. All exhibits to be left in the Home Industries tent at the show grounds between 2pm and 5.15pm on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> June 2011 as judging in **ALL** sections will take place that evening.
12. No second place prize will be awarded in any class unless there are at least 4 entries. Third prize will be awarded when there are 6 or more entries. If the judge is of the opinion that the exhibits are not of sufficiently high standard, no prizes will be awarded. The decision of the judges as to the merit of exhibits shall in all cases be final.
13. Exhibits may not be removed from the show before 4pm and then only with the secretary's permission. All exhibits not removed from the show grounds by 5.30pm will become the property of the Show Committee.

**Martha Straghan memorial cup:** Presented to the exhibitor gaining most points in classes A5-A6.

**Woodford cup:** Presented to the exhibitor gaining most points in classes G1-G10.
